



Csaba Borboly - short biography

Csaba Borboly (born 8. August 1974 in Gyergyótekerőpatak, Romania) graduated from the Márton Áron High School in Miercurea Ciuc with a degree in computer science and then he studied political management at the Századvég Political School (Budapest, Hungary). After that he studied political management at the Faculty of Law and Political Sciences of Eötvös Lóránd University (Budapest) and obtained a Master's degree in Public Administration at Babeş-Bolyai University (Romania).

As a student, he was the president of the school student council, participated in the founding and activities of various youth organizations, also he was president of the Transylvanian Civic School Foundation, and of the Foundation for Youth Research and Training. As one of the leaders of the Democratic Alliance of Hungarians in Romania (RMDSZ), he represented the interests not only of young people but of all hungarian minorities living in Romania, he was also a founding member of the Council of the Hungarian Youth Association, of the Federation of Youth Organisations of Ciuc Region, and secretary of the Hungarian Youth Conference from Romania (MIÉRT). Since 2007, he has been the President of the Territorial Organisation of DAHR Ciuc Region, he also took on responsibilities as vicepresident and member of professional bodies in other organisations, as well. **After being vice-president of the Harghita County Council from 2004, he took over the leadership of the County Council in 2008 and was re-elected in 2012, 2016 and 2020.**

Since October 2012, he is a permanent member of the Committee of the Regions, including the Social Policy, Education, Employment, Research and Culture Committee (SEDEC), the

Commission for Environment, Climate Change and Energy Committee (ENVE), as a member of the European People's Party.

He and his wife Melinda have been married since 1998 and have three daughters.
